

Adams was also behind creating some of the iconic villains in Batman't chronike, including Some of the iconic vinans in Batman's storyline, including Joker and Two-Face. He and famous comic book writer Dennis O'Neil joined hands to come out with the 'X-Men' series and they went on to work notably on the 'Batman' series which even later paved way for Batman movies. Adams was rejected by DC at the beginning and he started his career drawing for Archie Comics. 
