The global economy is now projected to grow by only 3.1 per cent in 2022, down from the 4.0 per cent growth forecast released in January 2022. Global inflation is projected to increase to 6.7 per cent in 2022, twice the average of 2.9 per cent during 2019-2020, with sharp rises in food and energy prices, it said. The report said that the outlook in South Asia has deteriorated in recent months, against the fragile economic recovery from the pandemic, triggering a devastating humanitarian crisis in the region. India's growth is forecast to be 6.4 per cent in 2022, down from the 8.8 per cent in 2021, as higher inflationary pressures and uneven recovery of the labour market will weigh on the growth. For the fiscal year 2022-23, India's growth is forecast to be 6 per cent.


