Petrol pumps in hinterland go dry

■ Govt claims sufficient supplies

■ New Delhi, Jun 15 (PTI): Some petrol pumps in states like Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Karnataka have run dry following a sudden surge in demand at PSLT outlets that followed the ban on fuel sales by private fuel retailers.

The government however said there were sufficient supplies of petrol and diesel to meet even demand that had increased due to rush to PSUs by brands.

In Madhya Pradesh, the oil minister said, the petrol sales rose 40.6 per cent and diesel by 46.1 per cent as compared to a 4.3 per cent and 2.9 per cent increase in the previous month and 30 per cent, respectively.

The Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved a proposal of the Department of Telecommunications to conduct spectrum auction through which spectrum will be auctioned to provide 5G services to public and enterprises, the ministry said in a statement.

PSU fuel retailers Indian Oil, HPCL and BPCL have increased oil and diesel prices in tandem with the rise in crude oil (raw material) costs.

"This has led to a loss of 20-25% a loss that private refiners Nayaara Energy, JioBP and Shell aren't able to absorb. A few petro pumps
