Raipur, Jun 19: The first showers that lashed the city from 10:20 am to 1 pm on Sunday, June 19, led to the arrival of monsoon in Chhattisgarh. The rain caused water-logging in several residential colonies and led to chaos in the city roads. The civic body was also criticised for the lack of preparedness of the Municipal Corporation to deal with the problem of water-logging. Residents in low lying areas are complaining that the increase in rains would further compound their problems.

According to the officials of the Municipal Corporation, the rain was not heavy but the problem of water logging was being run. But accumulation of rain water on the roads at some points of the city proved that there was a lack of preparation.

Local residents met the officials of the Municipal Corporation and requested them to take necessary steps regarding this problem but nothing has been done.
