Water logging in rly under-bridge posing problems is a recurring issue in the area. The newly constructed railway station coming under SCRR, which was constructed at the cost of Rs 3 crore is still facing water logging even after 18 months of its construction and causing huge problems to passer-by and public convenience. It was opened 18 months back. But the drainage system is fully choked and on top of it, there is constant seepage of water from the slab of the bridge. This under-bridge is being used by small cars, jeeps, motor-cycles and those on foot. But with water logging, even after light rains is posing lots of problems to the vehicle riders and passers-by.

It is for many months that the water logging is inside the railway under-bridge causing inconvenience to passer-by and it is leading to water-logging. The drains of Nagar drainage system are fully choked and on top of it, there is constant seepage of water from the slab of the bridge.

G7 leaders wrap up summit meant to bolster Ukraine support

The Group of Seven developed economies on Tuesday wraps up a summit in northeastern Germany, sending a strong signal of long-term commitment to Ukraine's future. The summit, which Russia pays a higher price for its invasion while also attempting to alleviate the global hunger crisis and show unity against climate change.

The G-7 has sought to assuage those concerns. While the group's annual gathering has been dominated by Ukraine and by the war's knock-on effects, such as the challenge to food supplies in parts of the world's major economies, the G-7 also can move ahead on pre-war priorities. The summit has been pre-occupied with securing agreement on the creation of a climate club, a joint statement that wants to speed ahead when it comes to tackling global warming.

New Delhi, June 28: The government will make it mandatory for car-makers to provide a minimum of six airbags in motor vehicles that can carry up to eight passengers for enhanced safety of occupants, Union minister for Road Transport and Highways Nitin Gadkari said on Monday.

He added: "We need co-operation from all stakeholders (including auto makers) as well as the automobile industry... We have decided to make it mandatory for all eight-seater vehicles of category M1, manufactured after October 1, 2022, shall be fitted with two side-impact torso air bags, one each for front row and rear row..."

Tata Motors to increase prices of commercial vehicles

New Delhi, June 28: Seeking to put in place a strict regulatory framework for the country, FSSAI has made it compulsory for manufacturers to display the logo specified by the agency for each product as well as ensure traceability of the products up to the level of manufacturers.

Tata Motors on Tuesday said it will increase the prices of its commercial vehicles, in the range of Rs 1.5 to 2.5 per cent, from July 1 to partially offset rising input costs.

In April, Tata Motors had hiked the prices of its passenger vehicles by 1.1 per cent and those of commercial vehicles by 1.5 per cent. The company said it will continue to monitor the market and adjust prices as needed.
