## A

 s students gear up for the academic year 2023-24, astorm is brewing over the new history and political scistorm is brewing over the new history and political sciEducational Research and Training (NCERT) for senior and senior secondary classes. The changes made to the curricu-
lum have raised concerns about the selective rewriting and lum have raised concerns about the selective rewriting and
distortion of history to suit a political agenda. One of the most egregious omissions in the new textbooks is the deletion of chapters related to Mahatma Gandhi's efforts to promote Hindu-Muslim unity in the months before and after the Partition of India in 1947. Gandhi's attempts were reportedly linked to his assassination and the subsequent ban on the Removing this portion of the study material deprives students of a holistic understanding of the period, denying them the opportunity to develop critical thinking and a broad out look on our social and political past. Similarly concerning is the removal of key aspects of the Mughal period and the events and downplaying others, the NCERT is distorting his tory and presenting a skewed version of the past. Adding to
the controversy is the surreptitious manner in which these the controversy is the surreptitious manner in which these were published last June, these alterations were not diswere published last June, these alterations were not dis-
closed, leading to accusations of bias and political interference. The NCERT Director's dismissal of the issue as a mere oversight" is unconvincing, given the apparent ideological shapes our understanding of the world and our place in it. I is essential that the curriculum is designed with great care and caution to ensure that it is objective, comprehensive, and ty. The NCERT books are endorsed by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) and many state school boards, meaning that the changes made to the curriculum will have a far-reaching impact on millions of impressionable youn the times and ensure that students are equipped with the skills and knowledge they need to thrive in a rapidly changing world. However, these changes must be made with the utmost care and diligence, and they must not be motivated by politicical considerations. When politics is allowed to enter
the classroom, it becomes a tool for propaganda rather than the classroom, it becomes a tool for propaganda rather than
education, and the consequences can be dire. The role of education is to empower individuals to think critically, to question the status quo, and to engage with the world in a meaningful way. It is not to indoctrinate them with a particula orldview or to promote a particular agenda. When education sed to divide rather than unite. The NCERT must take these concerns seriously and ensure that the curriculum is designed with the best interests of students in mind. This means providing a comprehensive and balanced view of history and politics, including the difficult and uncomfortable parts, and encouraging students to engage with these issues in a thoughtful and democratic society. It is essential that we protect it from the corrosive influence of politics and ensure that it remains a force for good in the world. The NCERT must act quickly to ad-
dress the concerns raised by these changes and restore faith dress the concerns raised by these changes and restore faith
in the integrity of our education system. Only then can we enin the integrity of our education system. Only then can we en-
sure that our students are equipped with the knowledge and sure that our students are equipped with the kn
skills they need to build a better future for us all.
