SC junks plea of 14 parties

The Supreme Court on Wednesday refused to entertain a plea by 14 parties, led by the Congress, alleging arbitrary use of cenprobe agencies against opposition leaders and seeking guidelines for the future.

New Delhi, Apr 05 (PTI):

A bench comprising Chief Justice D Chandrachud and Justice J B Pardiwala said that "laying down general guidelines without having relation to facts of a case will be dangerous".

Sensing the disinclination on the part of the top court in entertaining the plea, senior advocate A M Sighvi, appearing for the

'No plan to use Aadhaar data for census'

New Delhi, Apr 05 (PTI): The government has no plan to use Aadhaar data for census, Minister of State for Electronics and IT Rajeev Chandrasekhar told Lok Sabha on Wednesday. "The Office of the Registrar General and Census Commissioner of India has informed that there is no plan to use Aadhaar data for census," he said in a written reply. According to the Unique Identification Authority of India, more than 136 crore Aadhaar numbers have been issued by it till the end of February. ... after adjusting for the estimated number of deaths,

the estimated number of living Aadhaar number holders is 130.2 crore, which is over 94 per cent of the total projected population for 2022," Chandrasekhar said in reply to questions by Congress member Adoor Prakash.

Further, the minister said there is is no mechanism to receive the Aadhaar numbers of deceased persons from the Registrars appointed by state governments under the provisions of the Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969 for the registration of births and deaths, to de-activate those Aadhaar numbers.

Says independent press is necessary for democracy New Delhi, Apr 05 (PTI):

The Supreme Court on Wednesday quashed the Centre's telecast ban on Malayalam news channel MediaOne, and pulled up the Ministry of Home Affairs for raising national security claims from "thin air" without facts.

Observing that the State can't impose unreasonable restrictions on press as it would have a chilling effect on press freedom, a bench headed by Chief Justice DY Chandrachud set aside the Kerala High Court order which had upheld the Centre's decision to ban the channel's telecast on security grounds.

The top court said critical views of the channel against government policies cannot be termed as anti-establishment as an independent press is necessary for a robust democ-

"Press has a duty to speak truth to power and present citizens with hard facts enabling them to make choices that propel democracy in the right direction. The restriction on freedom of press compels citizens to think along the same tangent.



Woman confesses to killing infant son

Bhilai, Apr 05: Durg Police arrested a woman after she confessed to killing her infant son. She had tried to spin a false story of abduction and murder of her son. On the basis of CCTV footage, Police questioned her after which she confessed to the SP Dr Abhishek Pallava

informed that on March 31, one Malti Yaday of village Nagpura had lodged a complaint regarding missing / abduction of her 06month-old child Dipanshu Yadav. She complained that the child was sleeping with her and around 03:00 hrs she noticed that the child was missing. Initially an FIR was lodged under section 363 of IPC and investigation was

stituted to trace the missing child. The team inspected the crime scene and collected technical inputs. Every possible effort was being made to locate the kidnapped child with the help of CDR and CCTV footage. Meanwhile, on April 01, 2023, the dead body of the kidnapped child was recovered from Dabri pond of the village. Police team minutely examined the footage of the CCTV cameras installed in the village.

In the footage, a woman wearing a dark brown colour saree was seen carrying the child around 02:40 hrs in the night. Footage of the suspicious woman was shared with the villagers and was shown to the members of the victim family. The suspect was identified as



Malti Yadav, the mother of the child. Her sister-in-law Maya confirmed that Malti was wearing the same saree on the day of Jawara immersion.

Malti Yadav was taken into custody and interrogated. Soon she confessed to her crime. She informed that her husband had left her at her paternal home and was not even giving

money for expenses. She was worried for her child and was mentally upset. In a fit of rage, she picked up the child and threw him in the pond with the intention of killing him.

After returning back home, she woke up her mother and said that her child is not on the bed and someone has taken him away. Police have seized

Raipur, Apr 05: Senior Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) leader and former Chief Minister Dr. Raman Singh on Wednesday launched a scathing attack on the Chief Minister of Chhattisgarh, Bhupesh Bagnel, over his recent statement on the Nagrik Apurti Nigam (NAN) investigation. School being set up in dilapidated Mangal Bhavan

Mungeli, Apr 05: To bring quality and tightness in education, the school development committee formed by the government has become a mere stamp for running the schools of the region. Irregularities are being done in the implementation of government schemes and construction works due to the whims of the officers of the department and in the absence of supervision by the department, inconsistency is being done on large.

Similarly, the arrears have not been paid by the education department and similarly, the instructions of DPI were not followed even in the promotion of head reader, and on the arrival of the School Education Minister in the city, the Minister has asked for action against the guilty after conducting an inquiry. Complaints were made on the education minister's visit to the city, regarding schools being conducted in dilapidated rooms and non repair of



dilapidated schools. In many villages of the district, schools are running in borrowed buildings.

The old dilapidated buildings have been demolished but due to nonconstruction of new buildings, schools are being run in dilapidated community buildings and panchayat buildings. Government primary schools of Lalpur and Maradbari under Mungeli block will be set up in a small Mangal Bhavan and the schools built in 2012-13 in Thakurkapa under Gram Panchayat Tarwarpur are lying half-incomplete because funds have not yet been released for dilapidated schools.

A complaint has also been lodged by the office bearers of the School Development Committee and in this regard, Education Committee Chairman and District Panchavat Vice President Sanjit Banerjee said that the meeting of the Education Committee is being constantly ignored by the Education Officer and the meeting is not being held even after sending a letter to the Education Officer for calling the Standing Committee meeting, due to which the information about the departmental schemes of the government is not reaching

Ex-teachers, students write to principal, seek apology

More than 1,100 people, including former teachers and students of DU's IPCW, have expressed deep concern over the recent incident of alleged harassment at a fest and demanded an apology from Principal Poonam

They have also raised a host of questions regarding the incident questioning the management's action and reaction in a letter signed by all of them. The letter comes a week

"Why is the College threatening students with dire consequences if they continue their protests, calling parents of the already traumatised students and creating an atmosphere of fear through punitive measures?" they asked. "An apology would go a

long way in restoring confidence and the camaraderie that IPCW has had over the past 99 years. We demand that students will be able to send their chosen nominees to be members of the investigation

"She (Braverman) fails to take note of the systemic racism and ghettoisation of communities and omits to recognise the tremendous cultural, economic and political ontributions that British-Pakistanis continue to make in British society," Baloch said at a press conference here. In an interview about the UK government's plans to tackle child sexual abuse, Braverman spoke about "the predominance of British-Pakistani males who hold cultural values totally at odds with British values". "[British-Pakistani men] see women in a demeaned, illegitimate way, and pursue an outdated and frankly heinous approach

to the way we behave.

Braverman commented

after she was informed that a Home Office report in 2020 concluded that most child sexual abuse gangs are made up of white men under the age of 30 and that there was not enough evidence to suggest members of grooming gangs were disproportionately more likely to be Asian or Black.

Braverman pointed to reports from Rotherham town, which was rocked by a child sexual exploitation scandal in which five British-Pakistani men were convicted of grooming, raping and exploiting young girls.

India's Growth Forecast Lowered by World Bank and ADB

he report from the World Bank and the Asian Development Bank (ADB) downgraded India's growth forecast for 2023-24 (FY24) to 6.3 per cent and 6.4 per cent, respectively. The cause is attributed to the ongoing pandemic, slowdown in consumption, and challenging external conditions. The World Bank's India Development Update also suggests high borrowing costs and slower income growth are likely to dampen consumption and lower growth. The ADB report projects inflation to be 5 per cent, while the World Bank expects it to ease to 5.2 per cent in the current fiscal year. The decline in economic growth is not exclusive to India, with other South Asian countries also downgrading their forecasts, except for Bhutan. However, India's economy remains resilient and the country continues to show strong resilience to external shocks. India is one of the fastest-growing economies in the world despite significant challenges in the global environment. The Indian government has taken steps to improve transport infrastructure, logistics, and the business ecosystem. Private consumption and private investment are expected to drive growth in FY2024-25 ending March 2025, according to the ADB. The government is also likely to meet its fiscal deficit target of 5.9 per cent of GDP in 2023-24. The external front also looks promising, with the current account deficit projected to narrow to 2.1 per cent of GDP from an estimated 3 per cent in the current financial year due to robust service exports and a narrowing merchandise trade deficit. However, spillovers from recent developments in financial markets in the US and Europe could pose a risk to short-term investment flows to emerging markets, including India. Despite resilience amid slowing global growth, there are headwinds to India's growth in 2023-24. The recent financial sector turmoil in the US and Europe could reduce appetite for emerging market assets, trigger another bout of capital flight, and put pressure on the rupee. Tighter global financial conditions could also weigh on the risk appetite for private investment in India. Faster than expected inflation due to higher food or fuel prices may weigh on domestic demand. In Pakistan, growth is projected to drop to 0.4 per cent this year, assuming agreement on an IMF programme is reached. Sri Lanka's GDP is expected to contract by 4.3 per cent this year reflecting the lasting impact of the macro-debt crisis. The bank notes that the resumption of tourism and migration has supported growth in Maldives and Nepal, but high external debt and tightened global financial conditions pose risks to Maldives' fiscal and external accounts, and in Nepal, external shocks, domestic import restrictions, and a COVID-19 outbreak could also impact growth. India's growth forecast decline may be disappointing, but the country's economic performance amidst such challenging times shows great potential. The government's focus on improving transport infrastructure, logistics, and the business ecosystem is crucial for achieving sustainable growth. Private investment and consumption are expected to drive growth in the future, but there are risks to growth from external shocks and tighter global financial conditions. A s India gears up for the 2024 Lok Sabha elections, the Congress party, the main opposition entity with an all-India footprint, is being advised to first set its house in

order before leading the joint Opposition front against the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) and Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

Former Prime Minister H.D. Deve Gowda issued a fresh advisory to the Congress party, urging it to address its internal flaws before joining hands with other parties to form a united front against the BJP. While this may sound like sound advice, it is unlikely that the Congress leadership, which is still dominated by the Gandhi family, will pay any heed to it.

The issue with the Congress party is not new. As A.K. Antony, a senior Congress leader, pointed out a few months ago, the party needs to pay attention to the sentiments of the Hindu community, as it

is often perceived to be pro-Muslim. However, Congress party has been reluctant to accept any mistakes and take corrective measures. The recent defamation case against Rahul Gandhi, where the Congress president failed to follow up on the matter despite having a battery of top lawyers, is a case in point. Moreover, the leadership crisis in the Congress party is evident from the fact that senior leaders, including President Mallikarjun Kharge, have little ability to influence decisionmaking at the highest level. While the Congress party has a plethora of experienced politicians, the Gandhi family continues to be the final authority, disregarding any well-intentioned advice from within or

outside the party. The party's internal structure is in shambles, and it cannot be expected to rise above itself and correct its organizational flaws without a drastic change in approach.

If the Congress party fails to set its own house in order, the opposition camp is bound to be a divided house, jeopardizing its chances of presenting a united front against the BJP. The opposition may manage to stitch together a facade of unity, but it may not be able to form a firm stand on who should be the prime ministerial face of the opposition front, with multiple claimants to the position from different parties. As the legal case against Rahul Gandhi continues to unfold, it will be interesting to see how

the Congress party responds and whether it will take any corrective measures to rectify its organizational flaws. However, until such changes are made, it is unlikely that the Congress party can lead the joint opposition front against the BJP in the forthcoming Lok Sabha elections.

Govt not considering to regulate Al growth: Vaishnaw

New Delhi, Apr 05:

The government is neither considering to bring any law nor has any plans to regulate the growth of artificial intelligence in the country, Parliament informedwas Wednesday. and Telecom Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw in a written submission to the Lok Sabha said there are ethical concerns and risks around artificial intelligence, and the government agencies have started making efforts to standardise responsible AI and promote the adoption of the best practices.

"NITI Aayog has published a series of papers on the subject of Responsible AI for All. However, the government is not considering bringing a law or regulating the growth of artificial intelligence in the country," Vaishnaw said. In a reply



ChatGPT technology, Minister of State for Electronics and IT Rajeev Chandrasekhar said it is a Large Language Model launched by (LLM) OpenAI. "While it has made significant strides, there are still many challenges with these types of models," Chandrasekhar said. In response to a question on the step that the government is taking to regulate the growth of AI in the country, Vaishnaw said that the government is harnessing the poten-

sonalised and interactive citizen-centric services through digital public platforms. "However, Al has ethical concerns and risks due to issues such as bias and discrimination in decision-making, privacy violations, lack of transparency in AI systems, and questions about responsibility for harm caused by it. These concerns have been highlighted in the National Strategy for AI (NSAI) released in June 2018," Vaishnaw said.

The minister shared that the Ministry of (Meity), along with CDAC, has also initiated a proofof-concept project on AIRAWAT (AI Research, Analytics and Knowledge Dissemination Platform) for providing a common computing platform for AI research and knowledge assimilation.

Govt unveils plans to add 250GW renewable energy capacity in next five years India currently has a total

New Delhi, Apr 05:

The government on Wednesday announced a plan to add 250 GW of renewable energy capacity in the next five years to achieve its target of 500 GW of clean energy by 2030. The government has decided to invite bids for 50 GW of renewable energy capacity annually for the next five years i.e., from Financial Year 2023-24 till Financial Year 2027-28, a Ministry of New and Renewable Energy statement said. These annual bids of ISTS (Inter-State Transmission) connected renewable energy capacity will also include setting up of wind power capacity of at least 10 GW per annum, it stated. The plan fi-nalised by the Ministry of



New & Renewable Energy (MNRE) at a meeting chaired by Union Minister for Power & New and Renewable Energy R K Singh last week, is in accordance with the Prime Minister's announcement at COP26, of achieving 500 GW of installed electricity capacity from non-fossil fuel (Renewable Energy + Nuclear) sources by 2030.

renewable energy capacity of 168.96 GW (as of 28th February 2023) with about 82 GW at various stages of implementation and about 41 GW under tendering stage. This includes 64.38 GW of Solar Power, 51.79 GW of Hydro Power, 42.02 GW of Wind Power and 10.77 GW of BioPower. Considering the fact that Renewable Energy (RE) projects take around 18-24 months for commissioning, the bid plan will add 250 GW of renewable energy and ensure 500 GW of installed capacity by 2030. The Ministry of Power is already working on upgrading and adding the transmission system capacity for evacuating 500 GW of electricity from non-fossil fuel, it stated.







The buzz is that KKR's owner Shah Rukh Khan will be in the house when they return here after 1,438 days. They last played at Eden Gardens on April 28, 2019 — a 34run win over Mumbai Indians before COVID-19 hit the world.

Milne became only the third New Zealander to claim a five-wicket haul in a T20 international after Tim Southee (5-18 vs. Pakistan) and Lockie Ferguson (5-21 vs West Indies), helping the Black Caps bowl out Sri Lanka in exactly 19 overs. Opener Tim Seifert then hit an unbeaten 79 from 43 balls as New Zealand reached 146-1 in 14.4 overs to win with 32 balls to spare, finishing off with consecutive sixes. Milne's bag included the wickets of Kusal Perera (35) and Charith Asalanka (26.) who were half centurymakers in the first T20 match between the teams on Sunday which Sri Lanka won in a Super Over. He also dimissed opener Pathum Nissanka (0) and wrapped up the innings by clean bowling Pramod Madushan and Dilshan Madushanka. "Any time

Real Madrid earns most UEFA prize money with USD 146M in 2022



Geneva, Apr 05 (AP):

Champions League winner Real Madrid earned the most prize money from a European club competition last season with 133.7 million euros (USD 146.4 million), UEFA said on Wednesday.

Madrid's total included a basic payment for entering the group stage, results bonuses, a share of Spanish broadcasting rights and an extra payment based on clubs' historical records in UEFA competitions.

Liverpool lost the final to Madrid and was second in the "prize money table" with a total of 120 million euros (USD 131.4 million) UEFA's total

Champions League prize fund of more than 2 billion euros (USD 2.2 billion).

Only two other clubs earned nine-figure sums: Bayern Munich got nearly 110 million euros (USD million) Manchester City was paid nearly 109 million euros (USD 119 million).

Paris Saint-Germain's loss to Madrid in the round of 16 meant it was paid just 92 million euros (USD 100.7 million) by

UEFA said the 32 groupstage clubs were paid an average of 61.8 million euros (USD 67.7 million) with the lowest payment 23.7 million euros (USD 26 million) to Moldovan champion Sheriff.

Chelsea was eliminated by Madrid in the quarterfinals and earned 91.9 million euros (USD 100.6 million). Chelsea faces Madrid again in the quarterfinals this month and risks having no income from UEFA next season while it stands 11th in the English Premier League

Barcelona earned 64.6 million euros (USD 70.7 million) from Champions League group stage last season, then an additional 6.4 million euros (USD 7 million) from switching across to the Europa League knockout rounds. Barcelona lost in the quarterfinals to eventual winner Eintracht Frankfurt.

"There is nothing connecting me (Sisodia) to the proceeds of crime. Neither there are any allegations nor any material to show that I received the money, hid it or spent it," the coun-

He said Sisodia was not the only person responsible for formulating the excise policy which was approved at different levels.

"A committee was formed, certain recommendations were given. Cabinet decided to constitute a GoM (group of ministers). This GoM has a duty to recommend the changes. It is then the duty of the excise department to draft the policy. GoM does not draft the policy... The policy went to several departments. Everyone accepted it. It also went to the LG," he said.

'BJP is 'sinking ship' in K'taka, Cong a united force'

New Delhi, Apr 04 (PTI):

Terming the ruling BJP 'sinking ship' in Karnataka which even Prime Minister Narendra cannot Congress leaders on Tuesday said their party is "united" in the southern state and will ensure the "40 percent commission" government is ousted.

The Congress also claimed that it had information that the BJP is unable to select its candidates as "mass exodus" is happening in the party and Prime Minister Modi is "resorting to its last weapon of misusing Income Tax and ED officials" against Congress leaders and candidates.

AICC General Secretary Randeep Surjewala and former chief minister Siddaramaiah also dismissed reports claiming that the latter had pushed his case as a contender for the top post and said his statements to a channel were "misinterpreted". They

Siddaramaiah had never claimed that he would be the chief minister and had only stated that he is a contender and that the party high command would decide after consulting the elected MLAs on who the leader would be. Siddaramaiah and PCC president D K Shivakumar were in the national capital to attend the party's central elec-

Mallikarjun Kharge and former party chief Rahul Gandhi were present during the meeting, where the leadership discussed the allocation of tickets for the remaining 100 seats. The Congress was the first to declare 124 candidates for the May 10 election to the 224member Karnataka Assembly.

Surjewala told reporters that the screening committee and the Central Election Committee again met on Tuesday and discussed the probable candidates for the remaining seats and would declare some more seats by the late evening. He stressed that the leaders were unanimous while deciding on the party candidates for the upcoming elections.

Commission BJP Sarkara' in Karnataka has floundered and failed. The socalled 'double engine Sarkar' is a double-betrayal for Karnataka. Modi government betrays Karnataka on one hand and the Bommai government brazenly loots Karnataka on the other hand," he alleged.
