ndia's healthcare system is facing multiple challenges, and on medical devices. The recently approved National Medical Device Policy 2023 by the Union Cabinet is a step in the right direction to address this concern. The policy aims to reduce India's reliance on
imported medical devices and promote domestic production while ensuring quality control and keeping prices affordabluc. Currently, Insuria accounts for only $1.5 \%$ of the global medical device market,
Ind and the government hopes that the new policy will help the sector grow from $\$ 11$ billion to $\$ 50$ billion. This growth is crucial to improve
healthcare access and affordability for all Indians. However, achievhealthcare access and affordability for all Indians. However, achiev
ing this goal is not without challenges. The Parliamentary Standing ing this goal is not without challenges. The Parliamentar sel the lack o
Committee on Health and Family Welfare has pointed out high-end technology and raw materials, which makes manufactur them. The new policy seeks to address these challenges by promot ing research and development and establishing Centres of Excellence in academic and research institutions. It also supports the development of a skilled workforce for high-end manufacturing
and research, which is crucial for producing future-ready MedTech human resources. The policy also encourages partnerships with for-
eign academic and industry organizations to develop medical techeign academic and industry organizations to develop medical technologies in line with the world market. One of the most critical areas
of policy intervention is the creation of a Single Window Clearance of policy intervention is the creation of a Single Window Clearance
System for Licensing of Medical Devices. This will help ease the rocess of doing research and business while enhancing the role of regulation. The Production Linked Incentive scheme for medical devices and the medical devices park being set up will play a crucial
role in the implementation of the new policy. However, specific hallenges need to be addressed act policy's objectives. import dependence of electronic equipment, implants, and surgica instruments. These segments include highly essential and widely used high-end technology devices such as CT Scanners, MRI,
