Israel's Responsibility for Peace

The world witnessed a chilling turn of events when Hamas
launched a horrifying terror attack on Israel, marking a sinter shift in global terrorism. This highly organized assault, encompassing land, air, and sea, resulted in the loss of hundreds of Israili lives and escalated into a full-scale war. Israe 's govern-
ment swiftly retaliaited, oowing to eliminate terrorists worldwide, ment swiftly retaliated, vowing to e eliminate terrorists worddwide,
sparing no effort to obliterate their hideouts. The retaliaioun es to be fierce, with no restraints. As the terrorists rampaged through nearby, communitises, they yseized hostages and caaried
thried door-to-door executions of entire fanilies. This occurred despite the well-known terror threat emanating from the Gaza Strip, a region under intetnsive monitoring due to its volatile
nature. Hamas managed to catch Israel completety off guard. response from Tel Aviv, which, for once, found itself unprepared inister Beniamin Netanyahu, backed by his security cabinet, has declared their intent to neutralize Hamas' ability to Conricus has outlined Israel's objective: to oust the militant group from power in the besieged Gaza Strip. Concurrently, Hamas has expressed its desire to secure the release of all Palestinian pris-
oners held by Israel and put an end to Israeli provocations in the ccupied West Bank and Jerusalem. Of particular concern is the situation at Al-Aqsa Mosque, a perennial flashpoint in Jerusalem, earlier this year. While the United States, Western nations, and response has been guarded. has ignited speculation about its role in this audacious assault. The intensification of hostilities compounds the already volatill moil caused by the Russia-Ukraine conflict. Israel, known for it indifference to international reactions regarding its actions, is the Hamas strike should not obscure the broader reality: Israe has perpetuated this conflict for decades through its continued ccupation of Palestinian territories. Israel's efforts to establish Arabia and the UAE sharply contrast with the excesses it perperates against Palestinians. sele groups. One aims to eliminate it entirely, while the other advocates atter suggests job reservations solely for economically disadvantaged individuals, regardless of their castes. Caste remains a socia reality in India, with the India Human Development Survey (IHDS-2)
in 2011-12 revealing that 27 percent of respondents across India acknowledged the practice of untouchability in their daily lives.
Additionally, studies by the National Council of Applied Economic Research in 2016 reported that about $5 \%$ of marriages in India are inter-caste marriages. Caste identity is resistant to change through
economic means, as many who practice untouchability would still avoid well-off Dalits, while 95 out of 100 Indians hesitate to marry even affluent Dalits. Each Indian state has its allocation of Lok
Sabha seats; for example, Chhattisgarrh has 11 reserved seats based on "iitni abadi utna haq." This is vital for maintaining a federal struc-
ture. Similarly, reservations for SC ST, and OBC communities, in proportion to their populations, are necessary in government institutions to ensure social justice. Should we advocate the complete nomically disadvantaged candidates? cy for parliamentary seats? Such a move would harm the regional byance of power. The absence of state quotas in parliamentary
seats could lead to unequal representation among Indian states, akin to the Indian cricket team, where only a few states are repre sented in the whole country-an untenable situation for a parliaSabha constituencies are crucial to safeguard the interests of al Indian states, caste reservations are essential for the equitable dis-
tribution of power among all communities and castes in India. While offering more scholarships and financial support to the poor is ssential, it should not be confused with reservations like the EWS quota. Reservations are not charity but a means of achieving pro portional representation for states in Pariiament and for castes caste-based atrocities continue ton, plague our nation daily. Hence,
the need for precise and proportionate caste reservations based on current data is evident.
