Chinese military surveillance balloon spotted in Taiwan Strait
Taiwan's Defence
Ministry says a Chinese
military surveillance bal-

Mahua Moitra＇s Expulsion
Upholding Parliamentary Ethics

 While this decision was undoubtedly a momentous one，it is
imperative that we view it through the lens of upholding par
a liamentary ethics and maintaining the sanctity of our demo
cratic institutions．Moitra＇s journey from a fiery critic of the Modi government to being accused of accepting illegal gratifi standards of integrity and accountability expected from our
elected representatives．It is our duty，as the fourth estate，to ob－ elected representatives．It is our duty，as the fourth estate，to ob－
jectively analyze the events leading up to her expulsion and the implications it carries for our democracy．The allegations
against Moitra were grave，to say the least．She was accused o accepting bribes，including a substantial amount of cash and change for asking questions critical of the government in
Parliament．Furthermore，she admitted to sharing her parlia－ post questions directly．These allegations，if proven true，not only constitute a breach of parliamentary privilege but also
raise questions about the integrity of our elected representa－ tives．The Ethics Committee of Parliament，tasked with investi－
gating these allegations，concluded that＂allegations of accept
ing illegal gratification（are）clearly established and undeni－ able．＂Moreover，the committee found that Moitra＇s actions amounted to a quid pro quo，which is unbecoming of a Member
of Parliament and constitutes unethical conduct．In light of these findings，it is essential to acknowledge that the expulsion
was not a hasty decision but a culmination of a thorough inves－ tigation．Moitra＇s defiance and refusal to cooperate with the
Ethics Committee only complicated matterss Her allegations of
$\qquad$ a democracy，elected offficials should be willing to to subject them selves to scrutiny and due process when facing such allega
tions．The parliamentary proceedings leading to Miotras ex
pulsion were tumultuous，with opposition members demand ing access to the report and a discussion before any action was
taken．While parliamentary debates and discussions are essen tial components of our democratic process，it is equally impor
tant to recognize that the Ethics Committee had already con－
